Facts	What does Insurify do with my personal information?
Why?	<p>Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some, but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information.</p> <p>Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.</p>
What?	<p>The types of personal information Insurify collects and shares depend on the product or service. This information can include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Social Security number and income information • Contact details and demographic information • Family and financial information • Income, credit history, credit scores and employment information • Property and vehicle information (including general geolocation), driver's license information, driving history, and insurance information (including insurance claim history) <p>When you are no longer our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.</p>
How?	<p>All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons Insurify chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.</p>

Who we are	
Who is providing this notice?	Insurify, Inc. and its subsidiaries and affiliates, including, but not limited to, Insurify Insurance Agency, Inc. (collectively “Insurify”).
What we do	
How does Insurify protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we employ security measures that comply with federal law, including computer safeguards and secured files and buildings. Access to your information is limited only to Insurify employees who need it to do their work, and we require companies that work for us to protect your information, as well.
How does Insurify collect my personal information?	<p>We collect your personal information, for example, when you:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Visit our websites, create an account, give us your contact information, or sign up for our emails. • Apply for an insurance policy or another financial product or service • Communicate with us on our websites, over via chat, by email, or over the phone • Provide us with payment information, pay your insurance premium, or file a claim • Provide us with your employment and income information • Share your government ID and verify your identity <p>We also collect your personal information from others, such as business partners, brokers, agents, insurance carriers, or other companies.</p>
Why can't I limit all sharing?	<p>Federal law gives you the right to limit only:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes – information about your creditworthiness • Affiliates from using your information to market to you • Sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you <p>State laws may give you additional rights to limit sharing. See below for more on your rights under state law.</p> <p>Category of information shared with nonaffiliates to market to you: contact information.</p>
Definitions	
Affiliates	<p>Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies, including financial service providers such as insurance companies and insurance-related entities, and non-financial companies such as technology, real estate, sports and media, and consumer-experience companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • For example, Insurify affiliates include, but are not limited to, Insurify Insurance Agency, Inc, Inspop USA, LLC and its wholly owned subsidiaries.
Nonaffiliates	<p>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • These may include insurance carriers, service providers, advertising partners, and others.

Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Our joint marketing partners include insurance carriers, brokers, agents, business partners, and others.
